TFC foster parents and staff work to ensure regular and therapeutic visitation between children and their families. AGC staff is available to assist in visit supervision as needed. Parent coaching for biological parents, or family therapy is available as needed.

## Special Interventions Available Internally

AGC has a team of board certified therapists providing therapy to all leveled clients. Individual therapy and family therapy offered. Parent coaching is available for foster parents or biological parents as needed. Onsite trauma informed daycare available to foster parents at a discounted rate. Monthly support groups with childcare are offered for foster families.
