Special Interventions Available Internally

Foster parents are certified utilizing the SAFE Home Study Model and trained utilizing the NTDC state-approved curriculum. Parents receive Trauma Informed Care training, Child Sexual Abuse training, and additional trainings on identified topics through the Kentucky Just in Time training website.
