**Psychiatric Services**

Psychiatric services are provided on-site through contracted with a board certified Child Psychiatrist . Each child receives a psychiatric assessment following admission. On-going psychiatric services are provided to clients that present with issues surrounding mental health needs and/or psychotropic medication management. Typically a child can be seen with-in 2-3 business days. Urgent psychiatric services are available to address pressing issues, and for client's requiring services during non business hours and weekends. We also have 24 hour access to mobile crisis team services should a child present as a danger to self/others.
