We provide peer support services for those who struggle with both Mental Health and Substance Abuse issues. Our individual therapy consists of motivational interviewing, anger replacement therapy, cognitive-behavioral therapy, and trauma focused behavioral therapy. Hope Hill has an on site nurse who completes Nursing Assessments within 72 hours of intake and is available 24/7. Hope Hill's therapeutic foster care provides 24/7 hour crisis intervention. All services are in the youth's home.
