Necco Florence provides opportunity for birth families and foster families to work cooperatively within the guidelines of established state case plans. Necco provides transportation for visits, supervision as needed, and encourages the participation of birth families in their child's goals and treatment through formal invitations to Youth Service Plan meetings. Family therapy services are provided to the youth and birth family as discharge is identified.

## Special Interventions Available Internally

Necco Florence is able to provide the following services for families and children served by this agency: Individual and Group Therapy, Twenty Four Hour Crisis Support, Weekly Case Management, Family Therapy, Play Therapy, Grief and Loss Group, Behavior Modification, SOTP Trained Staff, Prime for Life Trained Staff, & GPS Sexual Abuse Trained Staff.
