Necco is a family company that serves at-risk youth through therapeutic foster care, alternatives to detention, independent living, mental health, residential and more. Working with foster parents, state workers, service providers and community resources we provide a holistic approach to children's services that stands to benefit not only the child, but the community as a whole. Our Independent & Transitional Living programs are an extension of services along a continuum of care offered to older youth / adolescents who are nearing the age of majority and the end of foster care. Our program focuses on skills that promote self-reliance, good citizenship, responsibility, and self-esteem – things that help youth mature into productive and successful adults. Currently, our independent living program serves youth ages 18 – to 21 that meet pre-determined criteria including: youth must remain committed to care, youth must attend a monthly Independent Living course, youth motivated to learn & grow, youth must have part-time employment, youth must work towards education goals, and youth must demonstrate an ability to save money for successful independence. For the Carter, Rowan, and Boyd County Independent and Transitional Living Programs, Necco has secured apartments that are located near community colleges, potential employment, shopping,

Psychiatric Services

Necco contracts with psychiatrists to provide medication management services. ILP youth are screened at admission by licensed clinicians to address immediate concerns, review current medications and diagnoses and to determine a psychiatric referral is needed. ILP youth that are identified as needed services are given assistance by Necco staff with making the ILP appointments. Necco staff also assist ILP youth with possible barriers including transportation issues, insurance concerns, appointment reminders and follow-ups, communication issues, and health advocacy.
