Currently, our independent living program serves youth ages 18 – to 21 that meet pre-determined criteria including: youth must remain committed to care, youth must attend a monthly Independent Living course, youth motivated to learn & grow, youth must have part-time employment, youth must work towards education goals, and youth must demonstrate an ability to save money for successful independence.
