Each youth has a permanency goal as part of their individualized freatment plan. Bio Families are invited to treatment plan meetings and encouraged to be engaged in the treatment planning process. We seek to strengthen family bonds and connections (parents, grandparents, siblings, aunts and uncles, cousins, etc.) whenever possible. We work with state workers, foster parents and family members to provide face-to-face bio family visits (supervised and unsupervised as ordered), telephone contact and home visits (as allowed). The youth's treatment plan includes (as individualized to need and circumstances) goals and objectives related to strengthening bonds with family and other pro-social adults. Family counseling is provided as indicated by each youth's treatment plan to work toward family reunification as appropriate. We will accept youth that do not have a high school diploma or GED (we will assist the youth with obtaining once in our program). All IL staff have been trained to complete the ASAP suicide assessment All therapeutic staff can complete substance abuse (PADDI-5) and domestic violence assessments for IL youth as well as offer C.A.R.F. skill training (Child-Adult, Relationship Enhancement
