## Describe How the Program Supports Family Connections

Staff is actively involved our youth's treatment team members 24/7/365. Staff members have experience in therapeutic foster care, DCBS, and working with biological family. Our agency support of our homes includes providing furniture, specialized equipment, electronic supervision, financial and physical support, and even daycare expenses in order to place a child or sibling group, and we will do whatever is possible to maintain placements and prevent disruptions.

## Special Interventions Available Internally

Sunrise Children's Services is licensed to serve the populations of foster care, therapeutic foster care, medically fragile, and foster-to-adopt, and we have specialized homes for parenting teens, large sibling groups, clients over the age of 18, and lower functioning children. Our program trains the entire treatment team in the Positive Discipline evidence-based practice model we use and specializes in the individualized treatment approach that every client deserves.
