Staff is on-site routinely for scheduled and unscheduled check-ins and support including transportation and on-site laundering. Staff can assist with homework, job seeking and retention, money management, living skills and transportation. Uspiritus Bellewood Bowling Green ILP provides 24/7 Therapeutic Case Management (minimum of weekly face-to-face contact), 24 hour crisis intervention, detailed monthly reports provided to the child's state worker. Young adults will receive financial assistance including \$100 on the first of each month (\$30 cell phone, \$40 allowance, \$10 personal, \$20 clothing allowance) and a \$120 gift card on the 15th of each month (minus program rent which is placed in youth savings to be released to youth upon exiting the program).

Uspiritus Bellewood Bowling Green ILP supports family connections through transportation to family visits (when available), family therapy as appropriate, and inclusion of family of origin in child's treatment team as appropriate.

Special Interventions Available Internally

Uspiritus ILP provides a continuum of quality services to help ensure children experience as few difficult transitions as possible including: Family Preservation, Outpatient BHSO, Therapeutic Foster Care, Independent Living, Residential Private Child Care & Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility. Uspiritus ILP also provides 24/7/365 support to young adults, weekly face to face therapy as well as family and in-apartment/house therapy. Uspiritus ILP as in house clinical staff who provide thorough initial intake assessment, face to face therapy, in home therapy, weekly therapy, and family/group therapy as needed. Uspiritus ILP works in collaboration with contracted psychiatrists and/or nurse practitioners for medication management. Uspiritus ILP has therapists specializing in sexual abuse, substance abuse, and disorders common to abused/neglected children. Uspiritus ILP provides Psycho-educational training and free random drug
