## Describe How the Program Supports Family Connections

Uspiritus offers family therapy sessions (usually twice/month per the treatment plan) on a flexible schedule. Uspiritus helps families (Zoom sessions, gas cards when available) to promote their participation. Parents are invited to treatment planning/educational meetings and to provide input into the treatment plan and educational meetings. Families are involved in any significant incidents through a notification and debriefing process. The child, therapist, and staff maintain regular contact with the family. Home and on-campus visits occur regularly, based on need and permanency plan.

## Special Interventions Available Internally

Uspiritus Bellewood provides treatment interventions designed to address most mental health diagnoses with additional focus on addressing issues related to past trauma, behavioral difficulties, increasing coping skills, etc. Uspiritus Bellewood has crisis consultation available 7 days a week by a licensed clinician designated to assist with crisis intervention and clinical issues. Uspiritus Bellewood offers mentors and tutors, independent living training, horticulture program, educational and job skills training components.
