## Describe How the Program Supports Family Connections

Uspiritus involves families in the treatment planning process and offers family therapy sessions on a flexible schedule that includes nights and weekends. Family therapy is offered a minimum of 1x per week, when indicated in the treatment plan. Families who are having financial difficulties or who travel a great distance can receive gas card vouchers to promote their participation in family therapy sessions. Parents are invited to treatment planning and educational meetings and provide regular input to the client's treatment plan. Uspiritus provides weekly visitation three days a week. Families are involved in any significant incidents that occur with their child through a notification and debriefing process. Additionally, the client, therapist, and staff maintain regular contact with the family. Home visits occur regularly, based on need and permanency plan. Each child at Uspiritus is actively working on a life book that promotes and/or supports their connections to their families.

## Special Interventions Available Internally

Uspiritus Bellewood provides treatment interventions designed to address any mental health diagnosis with additional focus on addressing issues related to past trauma, behavioral difficulties, increasing coping skills, etc. Uspiritus Bellewood has crisis consultation available 7 days a week during waking hours by a licensed clinician designated to assist with crisis intervention and clinical issues. Uspiritus Bellewood offers specialized treatment for sexually reactive youth, programming for substance abuse issues, psychological testing, mentors and tutors, independent living training, auto mechanics vocational training available on the Brooklawn campus through JCPS, horticulture program, educational and job skills training components.
