Our facility utilizes several community resources in order to provide additional services. Psychiatric services are offered at the Briscoe Clinic and the Trillium Center located at the Baptist Regional Medical Center; and Dr. R. Vasquez at Cumberland Valley Behavioral Health. Our direct care staff accompanies the residents to all psychiatric appointments in order to discuss their medication regimen with the doctors. Our therapists maintain contact with the psychiatrist on a regular basis in order to collaborate on all residents' progress and occasionally accompany the residents to their psychiatric appointments.
