Our program focuses on focuses on skills that promote self-reliance, good citizenship, responsibility, and self-esteem. We will accept youth that do not have a high school diploma or GED (we will assist the youth with obtaining once in our program). All IL staff have been trained to complete the ASAP suicide assessment All therapeutic staff can complete substance abuse (PADDI-5) and domestic violence assessments for IL youth as well as offer C.A.R.E skill training (Child-Adult Relationship Enhancement skills building).NECCO Florence works regularly with difficult children, including those with a history of severe mental health issues and/or criminally delinquent behaviors. We cater to accomodating the needs of the teen parent population, including daycare services. NECCO Florence is able to provide the following services for recommitted youth and/or their children: Individual and Group Therapy, Twenty Four Hour Crisis Support, Weekly Case Management, Family Therapy, Play Therapy, Grief and Loss Group, Behavior Modification, SOTP Trained Staff, Prime for Life Trained Staff, and GPS Sexual Abuse Trained Staff.
